

# Solar Panel Array Installed at the Aquatic Center in Destin



Have you noticed the rooftop panels on the locker room building at the Aquatic Center in Destin? The solar panel array was installed in mid-April, went fully on-line on April 24, and has been turning Florida sunshine into electric power ever since! This 24.09 kilowatt system includes 66 solar panels, all securely attached to the standing seam metal roof, tilted for maximum southeast exposure.

While the array does not supply ALL our power, it provides enough to reduce our electric bills by almost 25%. The fully automated system has an app that allows us to monitor the amount of power

each panel produces at a given time and the amount produced each day. See it for yourself via the SolarEdge app; log in with our [swimecff@gmail.com](mailto:swimecff@gmail.com) ID and DestinSolar2020 as the password.
